- → To (re)integrate into a research career in Europe
- → To built on previous trans-national mobility
- → To promote perspectives of research career development







Marie Curie Actions in FP7: ERG

Main features

- → Experienced researchers from Member States (MS) or Associated Countries (AC) having benefited of previous Marie Curie fellowship (MC) of at least 18 months
- → (Re)integration in a Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC), including the country of nationality of the applicant
- → Proposal to be submitted at the earliest 1 year before the end of the initial MC fellowship, and not later then 6 months following its end
- → Applications can be submitted continuously; evaluated and selected at regular intervals (cut-off dates of the call)
- → Grant agreement to be issued with the (re)integration host
- → Project duration: 2 up to 3 years
- → 15,000€ researcher/year during the period of reintegration







CO-FUNDING OF REGIONAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMES

Objectives:

 To supports existing or new regional, national and international fellowship programmes to increase transnational mobility for training and career development of experienced researchers









Main Features:

- Participants: public or private bodies operating fellowship programmes
- Community contribution: 40% of the fellowship costs of transnational fellowships
- Duration of a co-funded programme: 24 48 months
- Total available budget for the first Call: € 65 million
- Maximum contribution to a single applicant entity:
 € 5 million per Call









Eligible researchers:

Experienced researchers who at the time of the selection by a fellowship programme

- are in possession of a doctoral degree OR
- have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience after the degree which allowed them to embark on a doctorate in the country in which the degree/diploma was obtained or in the country where the fellowship is taking place









Eligible transnational mobility:

Programmes have to include at least one of the following activities:

- Outgoing mobility for a stay in another Member State, Associated or Third country
- Incoming mobility for fellowships to researchers from other Member States, Associated or Third countries
- Re-integration of researchers from Member States or Associated countries who spent at least three years in a Third country









Implementation:

- All Community co-funded fellowships must be evaluated and started within the duration of the grant agreement, and no fellowship costs can be claimed after its end
 - ➤ Example: a 24-month fellowship that starts 18 months before the end of the grant agreement can only claim fellowship costs for 18 months under the COFUND grant agreement
- It is therefore in the interest of the applicants to plan their programmes in such a way that the fellowships end within the duration of the grant agreement.









The Community contribution can be used to:

- Open up an existing programme for trans-national mobility
- Create a new trans-national programme
- Increase the numbers of trans-national fellowships awarded by a programme
- Improve the conditions of the fellows (e.g. by improving social security/pension conditions, extending the duration of the fellowship, promoting the implementation of the European Charter for Researchers.)









- Last Call Deadline: 13 March 2008
- Proposals: 45 received, none ineligible
- 17 participating countries:
- Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, Spain, France, Hungary, Italy, Luxembourg, Portugal, United Kingdom
- 2 Associated Countries: Switzerland and Turkey


Total available budget: 65M€

Objectives:

- To foster co-operation between public, non-commercial research organisations and private commercial enterprises based on joint research projects or programmes.
- To stimulate long-term collaboration between the sectors through movement of researchers between the non-commercial and commercial research domains.
- Diverse career possibilities and research experience for researchers, Knowledge sharing/cultural exchange, in particular SMEs







Main activities:

- Secondment exchange of know-how and experience through inter-sector two-way secondments of research staff of the participants, with in-built return mechanisms;
- Recruitment of experienced researchers from outside the partnership (optional);
- Networking activities, organisation of workshops and conferences, involving the participants' own research staff and external researchers;





Participants:

- one or more universities/research centre noncommercial
- one or more enterprises, in particular SMEs commercial
- Minimum: 1 from each sector from MS+MS/AC
- Additional participants from anywhere in the world







Non-Commercial participants:

- National organisations (e.g. universities, public non-commercial research centres etc.);
- Non-profit or charitable organisations (e.g. NGOs, trusts, etc.);
- International European interest organisations (e.g. CERN, EMBL, etc.);
- The Joint Research Centre of the European Commission;
- International organisations (e.g. WHO, UNESCO, etc.)

Commercial participants:

- Commercial enterprises of <u>all</u> sizes (incl. SMEs, spin offs, start ups);
- National organisations (if operating on a commercial basis)









Participants from which country?

4 categories

- EU Member States (MS)
- Associated Countries (AC): Switzerland, Israel, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Turkey, Croatia, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Serbia, Albania and Montenegro.
- International Cooperation Partner Countries (ICPC)
 based on three categories according to income per capita
 (low-income, lower-middle-income, or upper-middle-income).

Other (non-AC, non-ICPC) Third Countries (OTC)



Eligible researchers:

Secondment

- •Early-stage or Experienced researchers from participants
- Also managerial and technical staff
- Mobility 2-24 months

Recruitment

- •Experienced researchers from MS + AC + 3rd countries
- Mobility 12-24 months







Eligible researchers: MS, AC, ICPC and OTC

Early-stage researchers

- 0 ≤ Research experience ≤ 4 years
- No PhD

Experienced researchers

- PhD or at least 4 years of research experience
- At the time of recruitment







Nationality rules

Secondment:

No nationality restrictions

Recruitment:

- Nationals of any country other than that of host institution
- Nationals of ICPC or OTC can only be recruited by hosts located in MS or AC
- Researchers must not have resided or carried out their main activity in the country of the host for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to their recruitment

Eligible expenses for the activities carried out by the host organisations

- Contribution to the research/training/ToK programme expenses (E)*
 - Fixed amount of 800€ / researcher-month
- Contribution to the organisation of international conferences, workshops and events (F)
 - Fixed amount of 300€ / researcher-day for researchers from outside the network and for the duration of the event
- Management activities (G)
 - Max 3% of the total EC contribution
- Overheads -10% of direct costs (except subcontracts) (H)







Summary: Community Contribution

- Staff secondments
- Temporary hosting of recruited researchers
- Networking & workshops/conferences organisation costs for both staff members & researchers from outside partnership
- Specific small equipment for SMEs: <10% total contribution to the SME

International Dimension – World Fellowships

- International Outgoing Fellowships for Career Development (IOF)
- International Reintegration grants (IRG)
- International Incoming Fellowships (IIF)
- International Research Staff Exchange Scheme IRSES







Objectives

- → To reinforce the international dimension of the career of European researchers by training and acquisition of new knowledge in a Third Country (TC)
- → To transfer acquired knowledge in organisations from Member States (MS) or Associated Country (AC)









Main features

- → Fellowships of 2 phases: initial outgoing phase in a TC (*partner organisation*) and a mandatory re-integration phase in a MS or AC (*return host organisation*)
- → Experienced researchers from Member States (MS) or Associated Countries (AC)
- → Project duration: up to 36 months (outgoing phase:1-2 year(s); reintegration phase:1 year)
- → Application submitted by the researcher in conjunction with the host organisation
- → *Grant agreement* to be issued with the return host organisation in MS or AC






Objectives

- → To encourage European researchers abroad to reintegrate in a Member State (MS) or Associated Country (AC)
- → To offer them opportunities to capitalise in Europe on their international experience
- → To counter European brain drain to third countries
- → To allow lasting co-operation with third countries









Main features

- Re-integration in a MS or AC, including the country of nationality of the applicant
- Researchers must have carried out research outside Europe for at least 3 years at the relevant cut-off date of submission
- Project can address research activities, training, teaching, transfer of knowledge, development of co-operation with third countries...
- Applications can be submitted continuously; evaluated and selected at regular intervals (cut-off dates of the call)
- Grant agreement to be issued with the (re)integration host
- 25000€ per researcher/year during the period of reintegration of 2 up to a maximum of 4 years







Objectives

- → To reinforce the scientific excellence of the Member States (MS) and the Associated Countries (AC) through knowledge sharing with incoming researchers from Third Countries (TC)
- → To develop mutually beneficial research co-operation between Europe and TC









Main features

- → Experienced researchers from TC to carry out research in a MS or AC
- → Possible return phase of max 12 months for researchers coming from International Cooperation Partner Countries (ICPC)
- → Project duration: 12 up to 24 months (*return phase : 12 months*)
- → Application submitted by the researcher in conjunction with the host organisation in a MS or AC
- → Grant agreement to be issued with the host organisation in MS or AC- in case of return phase in an ICPC Grant agreement to be issued with the host located in ICPC


